

## **Cool hands** Luke takes Clwyd win

OLD 16-year-old Luke Jackson kept his cool to claim his biggest victory to date when he won the 72-luke Clwyd Open over the Wrexham and Prestatyn courses at the weekend, with a four-round total of 290, which was also the best nert score.
